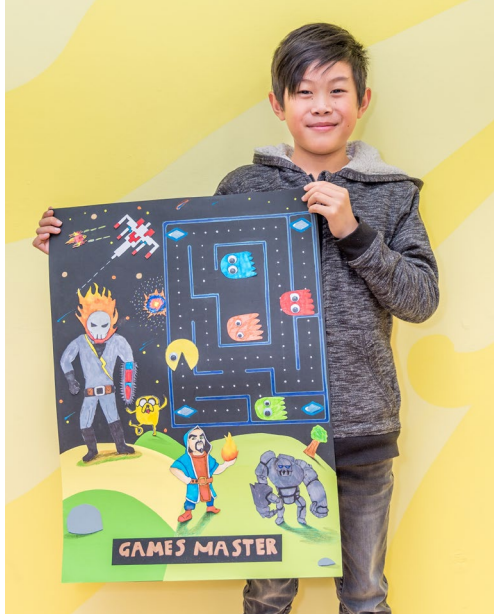

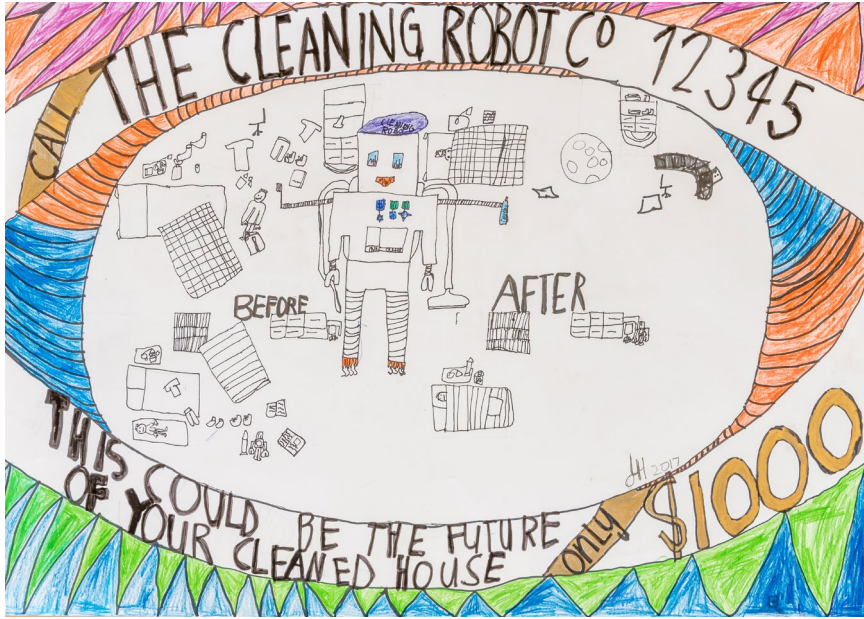


OTIS HAMMOND (9)
